Important 2012 AP Deadlines Approaching

- **March 30:** **Priority deadline.** Schools submit AP Exam orders by this date to ensure timely processing and delivery.
- **April 4:** **Deadline for ordering preadministration materials.** An order for preadministration materials can be placed only with the initial exam order. Orders placed by March 14 will be delivered by April 6. Orders placed between March 15 and April 4 will be delivered by April 30.
- **April 13:** **Extension Deadline.** Each order received after this date incurs a \$50 late fee (excluding alternate exam orders).
- **April 20:** **Final Deadline.** No orders will be accepted after this date. Orders placed by April 20 will be delivered by April 30.
- **May 7-11 and 14-18:** Regularly scheduled AP Exams are administered. Go to the College Board Website for the complete schedule of exam dates.

- **June 2012:** AP Exams are scored.

Advanced Placement (AP) Exams /Registration Fees for Eligible Low-Income Students—LEA Reimbursement Paperwork Procedures

We want to make you aware of a change mandated by the U. S. Department of Education regarding AP exam fee payments for students in A+ College Ready schools. Students who do not have free or reduced lunch status will be asked to pay a portion of the fee for mathematics, science, or English AP exams taken in May 2012. The full cost of the AP Exams will be paid for low-income students. Details about this change will be forthcoming.
