The ACCESS Franchise Model and It's FREE!

The ACCESS Franchise Model is an agreement between the school districts and the State Department of Education to use the content of selected ACCESS courses absolutely without charge.

The Franchise courses are stored on the Moodle Learning Management System (LMS).

All Alabama public schools (Grades 9-12) may use the course content as defined in the ACCESS Franchise Agreement and the Teacher Memorandum of Agreement.

Meets the requirements of Legislative Act 2015-89 (The Virtual Schools Act).

ACCESS Franchise provides:

- ❖ A Distance Learning Specialist to support the Franchise district
- ❖ Franchise Instructional Leadership Training
- ❖ Training on the Moodle Learning Management System
- ❖ Helpdesk support
- ❖ Course updates
- ❖ Mid-point and year-end visits with recommendations



Franchise School Districts should:

- ❖ Return the signed agreement six weeks prior to student activation
- ❖ Participate in the Franchise Instructional Leadership Training
- ❖ Notify Distance Learning Specialist two weeks before training session
- ❖ Provide a point of contact person for Franchise at district and school levels
- ❖ Serve only students residing and enrolled within the Franchise district
- ❖ Use the policies and procedures established by ACCESS
- ❖ Support, monitor, and implement Teacher Memorandum of Agreement
