## 2.04 Children's Book Rubric

### Your book content should include the following:

1. **Cover Page** which includes the title of your book, your name, and your school. (Be creative in your title. Titles are often the 1<sup>st</sup> things that readers see that make them want to read a book.) **(6pts)**
2. Your book should have between 8-12 pages of content.
3. You should include **images/pictures or illustrations** on each page to help show what you are telling in writing. (at least 6 depending on length) **(12pts)**
4. Include a **Works Cited** page where you list the web addresses (URLs) of the websites you used to get information and images. **(4pts)**
5. **Introduce your animal.**--(Be creative: you can give him a name, siblings, friends, etc.)—tell where he lives (often referred to as range) and how many of his species exist). **(10pts)**
6. Tell about your animal's **source of food** (what he eats). **(10pts)**
7. Tell about which **organisms depend on your animal for food**. **(10pts)**
8. Tell about what has **caused your animal to become endangered**. **(10pts)**
9. Tell what is being done to **help your animal**. **(10pts)**
