Project Steps

Step One: Use your knowledge of soils the soil orders and <u>USDA's Map of the Soils in Alabama</u> to write a 1-paragraph discussion post that includes the following information:

- 3-4 sentences about the soil in the area where you live.
- 3-4 sentences about the soil in an area of Alabama where you haven't been.

Post the paragraph to the **6.03 My Soil Discussion**. Your teacher will use this post to place you in a group.

<u>Step Two:</u> After your teacher assigns you to a group and an area of the state, work with your classmates to research that area in detail. Your teacher will set up a group discussion thread on **6.03 Group Work Discussion**. Your group should collect the following information about the area:

- Soil Type(s)
- Climate
- Topography
- Native plant life
- Crops that are grown

Work with each other to split up who should research each part and create a Powerpoint presentation with the information. Everyone should create some of the slides and one person should put together the final product. Your final presentation should include the following:

- Title slide with all group members names
- Map of Alabama with your area highlighted/identified
- Detailed area information:
 - Soil Type(s)
 - o Climate
 - Topography
 - o Native plant life
 - o Crops that are grown
- Works Cited slide with all outside sources

You can use information within the lessons as well as outside sources. Just remember to correctly cite all information. All ACCESS courses use MLA (Modern Language Association) format to cite sources. Read <u>MLA Citations – Instructions</u> for more information.

<u>Step Three:</u> One person in your group should post your group's final product to the **6.03 Soil Presentation Discussion**. Look at the other groups' presentations and comment on their completed work.

Step Four: Look at the other groups' presentations carefully and then individually complete **6.03 Project Summary Dropbox**.
