Questions are 5 points each = 20 points

**Insert the picture of your crime scene sketch below: 33 total points – 10 points for the sketch, 23 for the points detailed below**

1. Label your directional terms. **2 points**
2. Number each piece of evidence. **3 points**
3. Label your two fixed points, Point A and Point B. **1 point each (2 points total)**
4. Draw a light line (with a ruler) from Point A to each piece of evidence. Write each measurement (in cm) on each line. These should be the same distances you recorded in your chart. **5 points**
5. Repeat Step 12 with Point B. **5 points**
6. Refer back to your lesson on sketches to add all required information.
7. On your sketch, list your evidence with numbers and a brief description. This is your legend/key. **4 points**
8. Add a scale, or you can add “not drawn to scale” for this activity. **2 points**
9. Create a documentation block of the case number, date, time, location, and investigator (your) name. **1 point each (5 points total)**
