


Downloading and Installing Audacity


- 1) Go to the Audacity Website at <http://web.audacityteam.org/download/>
- 2) Click the download link for the operating system you are using.

5) If prompted to run or save the file, select **Save**.

7) Navigate to the location where you save the file and run the **Audacity Installer**.

8) Follow the instructions on screen to finish installation.
